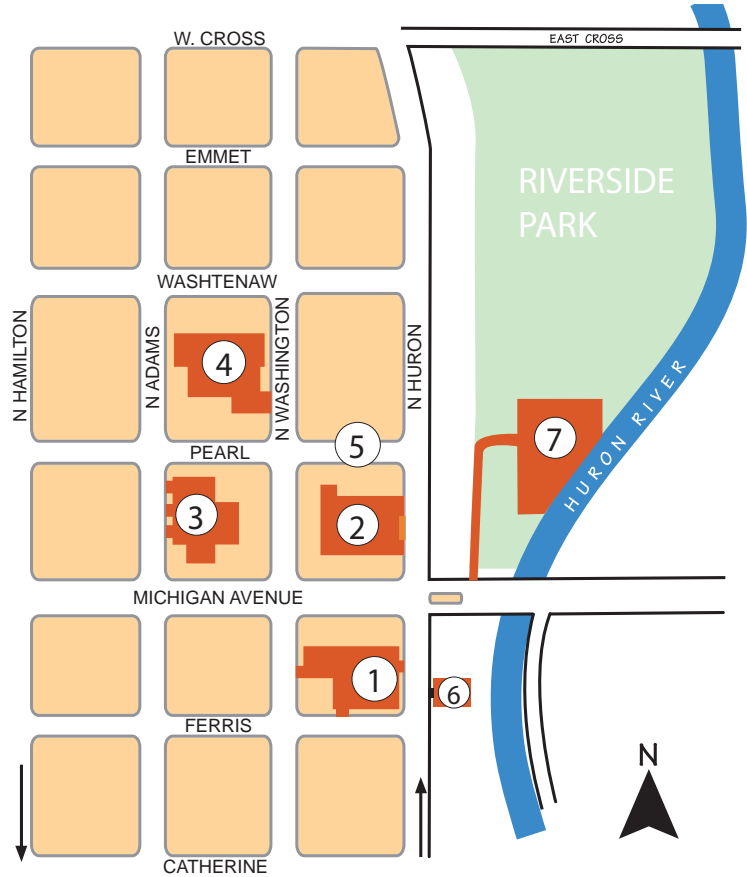


# Parking DOWNTOWN

Ypsilanti offers an abundance of parking throughout the city, and centered around City Hall, Downtown, Eastern Michigan University, and Ypsilanti parks. Some parking areas offer the first two hours free, while others charge a small fee.

Residential and Downtown parking permits are available through the City Treasurer's office. Residential parking permits are \$22 a year while Downtown parking permits are \$200 a year. Ypsilanti is a bike friendly community offering spaces for bicycle parking as well.



1. **S. HURON PUBLIC LOT** – enter on S. Huron or Ferris Streets for 1-hour free, 2-hour and 10-hour parking. Employee permits available.
  2. **N. HURON PUBLIC LOT** – enter on N. Huron Street for 2 hour free parking spaces.
  3. **N. ADAMS PUBLIC LOT** – enter on N. Adams Street for metered parking spaces.
  4. **N. WASHINGTON PUBLIC LOT** – enter on N. Washington Street for metered spaces.
  5. **PEARL STREET** – metered spaces between Huron and Washington Streets.
  6. **CITY HALL UPPER LOT** – enter on N. Huron Street for weekend or evenings.
  7. **RIVERSIDE PARK PUBLIC LOT** – enter from alley next to Ann Arbor Professional Pharmacy on Michigan Avenue.
- ON-STREET PARKING** – 2-hour free parking on Michigan Avenue and metered parking on Adams and Washington Streets.
